- **Tuition & Fees** – Remember that **all fees are due by the last day of school.** June and July payments can be dropped off in the school office Monday (9AM-1PM) Wednesday (9AM-12 NOON) or Friday (9AM- 1PM). If these days and times are inconvenient for you, you can leave your payment in the church office.
  - The first tuition payment for the upcoming school year will be due July 1 if you have chosen to be on the twelve month plan; August 1 if you have chosen the ten month plan. We are sending another copy of the registration information in today’s Monday envelope. Keep this and post it at home as your reference.
  - You can also mail your payment to the school office during the summer. All families will be receiving monthly invoices via email. Please refer to these e-statements as your reminder of your amount due.
  
- **Used Uniforms** are available anytime during the school day, or before and after dismissal. If you need to browse through the used uniform inventory to prepare for the upcoming school year please let the school office know.
  
- **Second Hot Lunch-** There will be a second hot lunch (pizza) this week on Friday. This is a fundraiser for 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation. There is a bright blue form. **Please keep this separate from the chicken nuggets lunch.**
