 - Remember that the **Extended Day Program (EDP)** is open to families who need to make special arrangements for their child (ren) during this last week with minimum days. The cost for non-contracted families is \$8.25/day (from dismissal time until 2:40 PM). Please *let us know in advance if you're planning to use the EDP this week* so we can properly staff on these days. Remember that children need to *bring their own lunch* when staying at EDP on these minimum days.
 - If you use EDP this week (except for families on contracts), please pay via cash or check this week in the school office. Otherwise, you will be billed and the balance will show on your June

statement which will be emailed to you, and your payment will need to be dropped off in the school office by June 5.
