- **Parent/Teacher conference** are Mar. 24th-27th. Sign-up sheets are now posted in the school office. Please schedule your conference as soon as possible. You may stop by or call the office.
- EDP is available for those that need it during the week of conferences (March 23-27). Please let the school office know if you will be sending your student to EDP so we can plan accordingly. The cost for non-contracted families is \$8.25/day per child (from 11:30 AM to 2:40 PM). After 2:40 PM, the cost would be the drop-in rate of \$2.75 per 15-minute increments.
- **Pizza Factory** Fundraiser is this Thursday, March 12th. The flyers are in the Monday envelopes.
- **Basketball** -4th and 5th grade basketball schedules are in the Monday envelope
Note: Jr High basketball uniforms need to be returned if you have not done so already.
- **Last Chance for Junior Olympics** – Our school has to register by **March 21st**. **We need a Coordinator** to take care of registration and a couple of volunteers to help with try outs and the event. The event is on March 28th at Cerro Coso Community College.
- This coming **Sunday, March 15 will be a School Mass at 10:30 AM at Saint Ann Church**. If your child attends Mass in their uniform, there will be a **free dress day on Wednesday, March 18th**. Check in with Mrs. Persico after Mass outside the school office.
- **Tuesday, March 17th**. Show your St. Patrick's spirit! Wear green, shamrocks, leprechauns, gold, rainbows, etc. Uniform bottoms are required.
- **Registration for next year will start soon!** If you have an outstanding balance, please stop by the office to pay your family account. You will not be able to register your child(ren) for the 2020-2021 school year until your family account is zero.

- **FACTS**-Starting the 2020-2021 school year, Saint Ann will be using the **FACTS website** for all **academic, attendance and billing information**. The Diocese is requiring all schools to switch to this Student Information System. Please look for information in the coming weeks.
- **Immunizations needed for the 2020-2021 school year for 7th graders-** All sixth graders going into the 7th grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 1st**.

As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.

- Thank you for another successful First Fish Fry!! A huge thank you to our new coordinators, Ricardo and Nancy Saenz and their Fish Fry crew!! Please continue to join us this Friday and each Friday in Lent (except Good Friday) for our wonderful **Fish Fry dinners!** It is very important that every school family make the effort to work at least one Fish Fry, if possible. This is a great opportunity to earn **parent participation hours**. The **sign-up sheets** are in the **school office**. We need help with set-up, serving, and clean-up. You do not need to have Safe Environment clearance to work at the Fish Frys. If you cannot work the dates hosted by your child's class, you may still sign up for another date. You can bring baked goods any of the dates. We also encourage you to join us for dinner that evening. The delicious dinner is worth the wait – especially if you're having fun visiting with the folks around you. Don't forget to **save paper grocery bags** for our fish fry dinners. Bags can be brought to the school office during school hours. Here are the dates and class assignments for the Fish Fries:

 - Beer and wine available for purchase
 - Baked goods available too
