**COVID Update:**

Kern County is currently still in the red tier, but there is a good chance with positive numbers on the rise that we could slip back into the purple tier. As of right now, if Kern County returns to the purple tier, our 7th and 8th grade students will be mandated to return to distance learning. If and when we return to the purple tier, we will send out a Gradelink email with more information about a date that 7th and 8th would be expected to return to distance learning. Our waiver for Kindergarten-6th grade remains in place, and students from these grades may continue with on campus learning. **With our school's waiver, it is mandated that every adult and child on campus (including elementary and middle school parking lots) wears a mask.** When it comes to before school drop-off and after school pick-up, you may choose to wait in the pick-up lane in front of the elementary campus so that you do not need to exit your vehicle; otherwise, masks must be worn.
