Welcome Back 7th and 8th Graders!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

- **The pumpkin contest** on Friday was awesome! All the pumpkins were so creative. We hope everyone had a wonderful Happy Halloween!.
- **Ice cream and Otter Pop** sales will start this Wednesday, November 4th at lunch time. Students will be able to purchase ice cream (\$1.00) or Otter pops (.25 cents) on all Wednesdays except during Lent.
- **Mrs. Fields** - The fundraiser started Oct 26th and the money and order forms are due back on Tuesday, November 17th. Students who sell at least 12 items will get a free box of chocolate chip cookies. The top three sellers will get SCRIP cards (\$100 for First, \$50 for Second and \$25 for Third). We are hoping this sale will help us make up some funds we would have made from our usual fundraisers such as the Fall Festival, Star Review, and the Holiday Bazaar.
- **Christmas Trees** The school will be doing their Christmas Tree Fundraiser a little differently this year since the Holiday Bazaar has been cancelled. The class room parents are working to create beautiful themed Christmas Trees to raffle off on November 25th at noon (you do not need to be present to win). There are sign-up sheets in the school office to **volunteer to sell raffle tickets** on Fridays before and after school (starting Nov. 6th) and after Masses on Saturday the 14th and 21st and Sunday the 15th and 22nd. This is a great way to earn those **parent fundraising hours**. You also get parent fundraising time for **donating** money or an item to your child's class tree (\$15.00 = 1/2 hour - \$30.00 = one hour)

The trees will be on display in the EDP room (only 2 people at a time allowed in)

Just a reminder – Fundraising keeps tuition costs down

- **Emergency Kits**- it is vitally important to turn this in for your child in case of an emergency where normal procedures are suspended and when a long wait on campus might be anticipated.
