Parking Lot Procedures

Dear Saint Ann Families,

The Chancery Office of the Diocese of Fresno has directed us to publish and enforce strict policies and procedures for the arrival and dismissal of school children. The following are the regulations for the 2019-2020 school year. Please share this information with your children.

- Students should not arrive on campus until 7:15 a.m. There is no yard duty supervision before this time and it is unsafe for students to be unattended. During the period from 7:15 a.m. to 7:30 a.m., all elementary students who are on school grounds will remain in the supervised quad area or in their classroom. Middle School students will remain in the Middle School under a teacher's supervision. To avoid being tardy, children should be dropped off by 7:25 a.m. Every child should be in the classroom ready to begin the day when the bell rings at 7:30 a.m.
- Parents have the option to drop off children in our drop off lane, which runs along the south side of our school office building. It is designated by yellow stripes. Please pull all the way forward to the west end of the building (near the pedestrian entry gate) and stop your vehicles completely prior to car doors opening. Students may only enter/exit through right side of vehicle. This is to prevent children from walking between vehicles. Students should go straight to the sidewalk, then walk west to pedestrian entry gate. This lane may be used for pick up as well.
- Parents must pull into a parking space if not using the drop off line. Escorting children to and from your vehicle will help avoid accidents. Please release your parking space promptly due to our limited number of parking spaces. Please do not leave your car unattended while the engine is running. In the elementary parking lot pedestrians must use the crosswalk or the walkway along the rectory.
- The parking spaces in front of the south classroom building and the spaces directly in front of the Parish Center will not be used for student drop off or pick up because of the great potential for accidents when backing out of these spaces.
- Children may be dropped off in the main parking lot in front of the school. Children may also be dropped off in the Middle School/Parish Center parking lot. After school, students will wait for rides in front of the south building between the School Office and the fifth grade classroom door. Middle School students and siblings of Middle School students may wait in front of the Middle School and Parish Center.
- Day care buses only will drop off and pick up children in the elementary parking lot after school. Children who ride these buses will wait on the benches in the quad for pick up. Parents may not drop off or pick up children in the back parking lot.
- Elementary bike riders, rollerbladers and skateboarders are to arrive and leave school via the sidewalk along the west side of the church – they should walk along the chapel walls until they reach the sidewalk in front of the south school building. Middle School students may enter the school grounds via the Norma Street parking lot. All students must carefully walk their bikes/rollerblades/skateboards while on the school grounds. No bike riding, rollerblading or skateboarding is allowed on campus. Bikes must be locked.
