Tuition rate for all students:

1 child = \$5,742.00 annual (10 mo. @ \$574.20 or 12 mo. @ \$478.50)
2 children = \$10,565.00 annual (10 mo. @ \$1,056.50 or 12 mo. @ \$880.42)
3(+) children = \$15,502.00 annual (10 mo. @ \$1,550.20 or 12 mo. @ \$1,291.83)
4% Discount for 1 Child = \$5,512.32; 2 Children = \$10,142.40; 3+ Children = \$14,881.92

Tuition Payment

Full payment of tuition on or before August 31, 2021 (Tuesday) will receive a four percent discount. Otherwise, tuition may be paid in ten equal monthly payments beginning August 1, 2021 (or twelve equal monthly payments beginning July 1, 2021). Payments are due the 1st of the month. A \$50.00 late fee will be applied if payment cannot be withdrawn from bank.

FACTS Billing

Payments will be deducted from your account based on the plan you choose. Incidental charges may occur throughout the year (athletics, drop-in EDP, library fee, scrip obligation, parent obligation and benefit raffle.) No payments will be made to the school office unless prior permission is granted. Payment selection will take place in the family portal during registration.

Annual Registration Fee (\$350.00 per student)

This non-refundable fee is used to pay costs directly related to the education of your child. This payment is due when you have officially registered online. **-NEW-** Families will be sent an email with registration instructions through FACTS Family Portal <https://stas-ca.client.renweb.com/pwr/>. *FACTS will deduct an additional \$10-returning student or \$20-new student for submission fees.*

Scrip: Each family has an obligation to raise 400% through scrip card purchases by March 31, 2022. If a family chooses not to participate in the scrip program, they agree to pay the \$400 buyout in addition to tuition.

Example of how scrip cards work: You purchase a Stater Brothers card for \$100.00 from the school. You use the full value of the \$100.00 card at Stater Brothers. Stater Brothers has given a 5% rebate back to the school, so \$5.00 (5% of \$100.00) is credited to your family obligation. The amount of scrip credit you earn is determined by the rebate each company gives to the school (Walmart is 2.5%, Pizza Factory is 20%, etc.).

Parent Participation Hours – 30 hours per year (2-Parent Family); 15 hours per year (1-Parent Family)

Every week there are suggestions for earning parent hours in the principal and teachers' newsletters. An assessment of \$30.00 per hour (for each hour that a family is below their 30-hour / 15-hour obligation) will be applied towards family account at the end of the school year. 50 % of your family hours must be through fundraising activities. The deadline to earn parent hours is May 1, 2022.

Benefit Dinner Raffle Ticket (\$250.00 Each)

All families are obligated to purchase or sell one raffle ticket prior to one week before the benefit date in February 2022. Those families wishing to sell, rather than purchase, may sign up to sell after masses. If a family does not sell or buy their ticket, \$250 will applied to your account.

Tuition Assistance

The Diocese of Fresno provides tuition assistance to the neediest families regardless of their religious denomination. Saint Ann school also offers in-house tuition assistance, but funds are limited. In order to apply for tuition assistance, you must first use the FACTS Tuition Mgt. & Financial Aid Service. **Go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid> for filing online; the cost is \$24.00 and families have until April 15th to apply.** After you have submitted your application to FACTS, the office will call you to schedule an appointment with the principal to further discuss your tuition assistance needs. No appointments will be scheduled unless the FACT application has been completed.

Families that are currently in arrears will not be permitted to register for the 2021 – 2022 school year until their account balance is settled. Please make an appointment with the principal immediately if you have concerns.
