*Saint Ann School News*

- **Reminder:** Parents, there is no supervision for students before 7:15 AM at school. Students may be on campus at 7:15 AM. ***Any child on the school grounds before 7:15 AM must be supervised by parents/guardians.***
- A number of parents have asked about protocol regarding students when they are sick as we deal with COVID and the Delta variant. The school is doing all that we possibly can to keep students and staff safe from COVID, and we certainly don't want to pass on other germs either. It is extremely important that your child has a mask that covers them appropriately, and that they have extra masks in case they lose it or it becomes dirty. Students are instructed to sanitize as they arrive in the morning, before eating, before reentering the classroom, and after using a tissue or using the restroom. The bottom line is if your child's coughing or sneezing is excessive, for their health and the health of others, you may want to consider keeping them home. If your child develops a fever, they must be fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medicine (i.e. Tylenol) before they can return to school.

- **Volunteers-** If you would like to volunteer at the school you will need to do the Safe Environment online training, finger prints, TB screening and sign the Code of Conduct. The paperwork is available in the school office. If you want to drive for Field Trips, we will also need a copy of your Driver's License, Registration and Insurance Declaration showing that you have coverage for \$100,000-\$300,000 liability and also sign a Volunteer Driver statement (available in the school office). **All of this must be on file in order to volunteer in the classroom and or drive for a field trip.**
