- **Seder Meal** – We are looking for Coordinators to help with the Seder Meal. If you're interested, please contact the school office. This is a yearly tradition that students eagerly look forward to, and it's a great way to earn parent hours! **If we don't have volunteers, we'll have to cancel this event.**
- **Immunizations needed for the 2023-2024 school year for 7<sup>th</sup> graders** – All sixth graders going into the 7<sup>th</sup> grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 8.** All students have complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date.  
As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.

- In order to receive tuition assistance, you must first use the FACTS Tuition Mgt. & Financial Aid Service. **Go to <https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid> for filing online; the cost is \$24.00 and families have until April 15<sup>th</sup> to apply.** After you have submitted your application to FACTS we will call you to schedule an appointment with the principal to further discuss your tuition assistance needs. No appointments will be scheduled unless the FACT application has been completed.
- **The Pink Thursday Hot lunch slip** is in the Monday envelope. The slip AND money are due by Tuesday @ 11:00 AM. We will only accept late hot lunch slips if the student was absent on the previous day.
