



- April is the “**Month of the Military Child**” and every Wednesday students are invited to wear a purple shirt (with their uniform bottoms) to honor our military.
- **Junior Olympics** – Will be held at Cerro Coso Community College track on Saturday, April 15, 2023. Please fill out a permission slip if you would like your child to practice and attend.



Age groups and allowable number of events are as follows: Bantam (born in 2013 or 2014) Maximum of 3 events, including a relay; Youth (born in 2009 or 2010) Maximum of 4 events, including a relay; and Intermediate (born in 2007 or 2008) Maximum of 4 events, including a relay. This is in accordance with USA Track and Field regulations.

- **CJSF** – CJSF students are asking for donations for our local animal shelter. Please consider donating dog/cat wet and dry food (canned food should be pate, and no Ol'Roy, please), blankets, towels, wash rags, dish soap and Clorox bleach. - **Seder Meal** – We are looking for Coordinators to help with the Seder Meal. If you're interested, please contact the school office. This is a yearly tradition that students eagerly look forward to, and it's a great way to earn parent hours! **If we don't have volunteers, we'll have to cancel this event.**
- **School Stations of the Cross** during Lent will be Mondays at 9:00 AM – 9:45 AM in the church.
- **ARK (Religion) Testing:** Students in Grades 2-8 will take the ARK Religion test starting March 27th. We began this test last year, which replaced the ACRE religion test that students took in Grades 5 and 8. This test will show us areas of strength and areas for growth in the Catholic faith. Testing ends April 7.
- **Immunizations needed for the 2023-2024 school year for 7th graders** – All sixth graders going into the 7th grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 8.** All students need to have complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date. As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.
- In order to receive tuition assistance, you must first use the FACTS Tuition Mgt. & Financial Aid Service. **Go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid> for filing online; the cost is \$24.00 and families have until April 14th to apply.** After you have submitted your application to FACTS we will call you to schedule an appointment with the principal to further discuss your tuition assistance needs. No appointments will be scheduled unless the FACTS application has been completed.
- **The Pink Thursday Hot lunch slip** is in the Monday envelope. The slip AND money are due by Tuesday @ 11:00 AM. We will only accept late hot lunch slips if the student was absent on the previous day.
