o Emergency Preparedness Kit Cover Letter, Information Form, and Baggie

The information on the form and in your child's kit is extremely important for responding to an emergency at school. Additionally, we would like to suggest that you include a reassuring letter telling your child(ren) what may be expected in case of emergency and that you love them. However, do not make promises because you may not be able to keep them. You may also wish to enclose something to keep them busy in the event of a long wait before being picked up (playing cards, scrap paper and crayons, etc.). Please return this emergency form and the kit to your classroom teacher no later than **Friday, August 11th**

o Medication Forms for Prescribed and for Non-Prescribed or Over-the-Counter Medication

A medication form will need to be filled out if your child takes medication at school. **One form must be filled out for** <u>each</u> medication. Please refer to the Medications section of the Parent and Student Handbook for further information regarding medication. Remember, all medication (including aspirin) must be kept in the school office. These Diocesan forms must be completed and be on file in the school office <u>before</u> assistance with administering medication will be given.

o Volunteer Driver Statement

All drivers/Volunteers must complete our Safe Environment Training if completed before January 2023. Signed Code of Conduct, had your fingerprints cleared by the Diocese and a TB screening on record. If you would like to drive on field trips, the following documentation must be submitted **prior to the date of the field trip**:

- the signed Volunteer Driver Statement form
- a copy of your driver's license (and re-submitted if expires during school year)
- a copy of your vehicle registration (and re-submitted if expires during school year)
- a copy of your vehicle insurance policy (and re-submitted if expires during school year) (showing at least \$100,000 / \$300,000 liability insurance)

Ice Cream on Wednesdays (not during Lent)

Ice cream sales will start on August 16th. Ice cream (\$1.00 each) and Otter Pops (50¢ each) are sold by the milk room after students have finished eating their lunches. Students may redeem 'Birthday' and 'Student of the Week' certificates for an Otter Pop.

Milk will be available starting the week of August 14^{th} . White milk and chocolate milk are available for sale each day for 40ϕ per carton. Each class has its own system for purchasing milk. Please let the teacher(s) know if interested. If you want to pay for the full year in advance, the cost would be \$65.00.
