

- Rice Bowls are in today's Monday Envelope. What is a rice bowl? It is a staple on the table of Catholic families during Lent. The simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms (your spare change for example). It comes with a Lenten calendar that guides families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, stories and recipes. We will collect the rice bowls when we come back after the Easter Recess.
- 1st grade class will be collecting donations to make care bags for the poor which will be donated to the Salvation Army to be given to those in need. All donations can be turned in to your child's teacher or the first grade classroom. All donations are due by March 8<sup>th</sup>.
  - K : Saltines/Clubhouse crackers and canned soup with a pop-top opening
  - 1<sup>st</sup> : Multipacks of freeze dried fruit and multipacks of nuts/trail mix
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> : Mini tissue packs and sock multipacks
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> : Cracker sandwiches and travel size sunscreen
  - 4<sup>th</sup> : Water and deodorant
  - 5<sup>th</sup> : Chapstick and travel size sunscreen
  - 6<sup>th</sup> : Bandaids and deodorant
  - 7<sup>th</sup> : Combs and beef jerky (snack packs or individually packed sticks)
  - 8<sup>th</sup> : Multipacks of freeze dried fruit and deodorant
  - Also needed: travel size body wash, soap, shampoo and conditioner if you have some from travel to hotels, etc. we'd love them!
