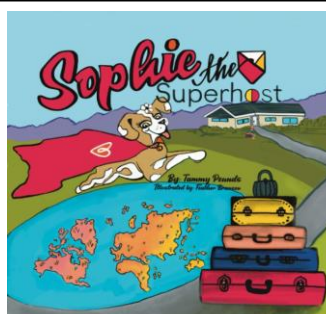
Parent- Teacher Conferences will be March 13th -15th. Conferences can be in person or via Zoom. A copy of scheduled conferences are in today's Monday envelope



➤ **Seder Meal** – The Seder Plate is the focal point of the first two nights of Passover. The Seder tells the story of Exodus through the senses of sight, taste, and feeling. The plate traditionally has five or six items which each represent a part or multiple parts of the Passover story. The Seder plate holds these things with deep symbolism: A roasted egg, which is a sign of new life. Bitter herbs to remind us of the ancient Jews' hard lives. Parsley to represent spring (which we dip in salt water depicting Jewish people's tears)

Books will be available for purchase and have signed if you'd like after school on March 21st in front of the library. Most, if not all, students were able to meet Tammy and Sophie in the classroom.

- **Immunizations needed for the 2024-2025 school year for 7th graders.** All sixth graders going into the 7th grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 8.** All students need complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date. As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.
- Do you need Parent Participation Hours? May 1 is the deadline for logging all of your hours for this year. Helping with Fish Frys is a great way to earn hours. Please keep in mind that half your hours MUST be fundraising (anything that makes the school money).
 - Two parent family = 30 hours
 - One parent family = 15 hours
 - \$30/per hour not recorded
