

- Immunizations needed for the 2024-2025 school year for 7th graders. All sixth graders going into the 7th grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. Bring the shot records to the school office by August 8. All students need complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date. As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of Varicella and a Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.

• **Registration 2024-2025** – Login into family portal link https://stas-ca.client.renweb.com/pwr/ Apply/Enroll. A Late fee of \$50.00 will be applied for those who did not register by April 12, 2024. Registration Fee: If you would like to make payments arrangements, please email Mrs. Sherrick with your payment plan. All registration payments must be paid by August 1, 2023. If your family isn't returning to Saint Ann, please let the office know so we don't overwhelm you with emails.

In order to receive tuition assistance, you must first use the FACTS Tuition Mgt. & Financial Aid Service. <u>Go to</u> <u>online.factsmgt.com/aid for filing online; the cost is \$24.00 and families have until April 15th to apply.</u> After you have submitted your application to FACTS we will call you to schedule an appointment with the principal to further discuss your tuition assistance needs. No appointments will be scheduled unless the FACT application has been completed. If you received diocesan and/or in-house tuition assistance for the 2023-2024 school year, and you anticipate that you'll need financial assistance again for the 2024-2025 school year, you must apply through facts and office to schedule an appointment with the principal to further your tuition assistance needs.

• Do you need Parent Participation Hours? May 1 is the deadline for logging all of your hours for this year. Helping with Fish Frys is a great way to earn hours.
