Tuition statements will be sent by email at the beginning of each month. Please remember that tuition is due by the first of each month. A \$50.00 late fee will be imposed if tuition is not paid by the fifth of each month.

We understand that there are many matters for you to take care of at this time. However, your completion of these tasks in a timely manner will help us care for your child's needs and then focus our energy on providing a quality education for your child. We thank God for the gift of faithful and supportive parents within our school community.

Please complete this blue form and return it to your teacher **tomorrow**, (Thursday, August 07th) **This is the most important piece of paper in your child's Monday Envelope.**

o Emergency Preparedness Kit Cover Letter, Information Form, and Baggie

The information on the form and in your child's kit is extremely important for responding to an emergency at school. Additionally, we would like to suggest that you include a reassuring letter telling your child(ren) what may be expected in case of emergency and that you love them. However, do not make promises because you may not be able to keep them. You may also wish to enclose something to keep them busy in the event of a long wait before being picked up (playing cards, scrap paper and crayons, etc.). Please return this emergency form and the kit to your classroom teacher no later than **Thursday, August 14**th

Milk - White milk and chocolate milk will be available for sale starting the week of August 11th. Daily/weekly payments will no longer be accepted. If you want to pay for the full year in advance, the cost would be \$73.00 "per child" for the full year or \$36.50 "per child" for half the year.

- Medication Forms for Prescribed and for Non-Prescribed or Over-the-Counter Medication A medication form will need to be filled out if your child takes medication at school. One form must be filled out for each medication. Please refer to the Medications section of the Parent and Student Handbook for further information regarding medication. Remember, all medication (including aspirin) must be kept in the school office. These Diocesan forms must be completed and be on file in the school office before assistance with administering medication will be given.
- Safe Environment Training All Volunteers must complete our Safe Environment Training.
- **o** Volunteer Driver Statement

All drivers/Volunteers must complete our Safe Environment Training if completed before January 2023. Signed Code of Conduct, had your fingerprints cleared by the Diocese and a TB screening on record. If you would like to drive on field trips, the following documentation must be submitted **prior to the date of the field trip**:

- the signed Volunteer Driver Statement form
- a copy of your driver's license (and re-submitted if expires during school year)
- a copy of your vehicle registration (and re-submitted if expires during school year)
- a copy of your vehicle insurance policy (and re-submitted if expires during school year) (showing at least \$100,000 / \$300,000 liability insurance)
