• **Child Care Statements for Tax Purposes** – Through Family Portal Financial Tax or by logging into FACTS Financial account.

1. Select Payment Plan & Billing
2. Select “View Payment Summary”
3. Set the year to 2025 and set your dates to 1/1/2025 – 12/31/2025
4. Print Payment Summary. This includes name, address and Tax ID number for Saint Ann.

This will show all monies paid to the school for the 2025 tax year. Not everything shown is tax deductible. Tuition, registration and fees for K – 8 students are not. Extended Day Program is tax deductible.
