
During Lunch Time



- **Immunizations needed for the 2026-2027 school year for 7th graders.** All sixth graders going into the 7th grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 4th.** All students need complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date. As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.
