- Carnival Wednesday, May 27th – Students can come to school in free dress. Straps should be at least 3 inches wide no bare midribs, excessively short hemlines or flip – flops are not permitted. Any student not in appropriate dress code will change into a school uniform that we have on hand. Some activities will involve water, so please send your child with a change of clothes, a towel and sunscreen. Please contact the school office if you have any questions.
- **Upcoming Minimum Days:** Wednesday, May 27th, Thursday, May 28th and Friday, May 29th are minimum days with an 11:30 AM dismissal time. (EDP will be available)
- **Immunizations needed for the 2026-2027 school year for 7th graders.** All sixth graders going into the 7th grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 6th.** All students need complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date. As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.
- **Used Uniforms** – are available anytime during the school day, or before and after dismissal. If you need to browse through the used uniform inventory to prepare for the upcoming school year, please let the school office know. If your student is promoting or your family is not returning to Saint Ann, please consider donating uniforms back to the school.
