- We are in need of parents for the PTG Carnival for additional supervision of students. Parents must be Safe Environment cleared. Please call the school office to sign up.
- Carnival Wednesday, May 27<sup>th</sup> – Students can come to school in free dress. Shirts must have sleeves, no bare midribs, excessively short hemlines or flip – flops are not permitted. Water shoes or sandals with a back are permitted. Any student not in appropriate dress code will change into a school uniform that we have on hand. Some activities will involve water, so please send your child with a change of clothes, a towel and sunscreen. Please contact the school office if you have any questions.



Kindergarten promotion: Wednesday, May 27<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 PM in the Parish Hall.

- If your child(ren) has medication or cough drops stored in the office, be sure to pick up the medication by the last day of school, Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. Students are not allowed to transport medication to/from school. Medication must be picked up by an adult. You may pick up a new Medication Administration Form for the 2026-2027 school year as well. A new form is required each school year. Any Medication left after May 29, 2026 will be disposed of.
- Our students will celebrate this month of Mary by praying the rosary daily and praying a decade of the rosary at 7:30 AM in the Grotto every Wednesday morning. Parents and guardians are welcome to join us.
- We invite all of you to the Promotion Mass for our 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students on Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, at 8:15 AM in the church. We will have a promotion ceremony at 10:30 AM in the church recognizing the achievements of these wonderful young people and praying for them as they begin their high school years.
- **Promotion Dress Code for 8<sup>th</sup> grade** – Boys need to wear nice slacks and a dress shirt. No jeans. Tie and jacket are optional. Girls need to wear a dress or skirt and blouse. Dress must be knee length. Straps should be at least 3 inches wide (or wear a non – transparent cover over more narrow straps). **No makeup is allowed.** Halter necks, bare midriiffs, plunging necklines, excessively short hemlines or flip – flops are not permitted. Any student not in appropriate dress will change into a school uniform that we have on hand. Please contact the school office if you have any questions. **Promotion Lunch Tickets are in today’s Monday Envelopes. Tickets must be present in order to attend. A Ticket for each promoting eight grader/parents was included in with the purchased tickets.**
- **Upcoming Minimum Days:** Wednesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup> and Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup> are minimum days with an 11:30 AM dismissal time. (EDP will be available)
- **Immunizations needed for the 2026-2027 school year for 7<sup>th</sup> graders.** All sixth graders going into the 7<sup>th</sup> grade must have the TDAP booster shot and a second Varicella. **Bring the shot records to the school office by August 6<sup>th</sup>.** All students need complete records of immunizations prior to entering school. Children will not be admitted to a classroom unless their immunizations are up-to-date. As of July 1, 2019, California Health Laws require that students entering the 7th grade must have two doses of **Varicella** and a **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** booster, given after age 7, prior to entering the 7th grade. This school immunization law affects all students in public and private schools.
- **Used Uniforms** – are available anytime during the school day, or before and after dismissal. If you need to browse through the used uniform inventory to prepare for the upcoming school year, please let the school office know. If your student is promoting or your family is not returning to Saint Ann, please consider donating uniforms back to the school.
